With the Sunday schedule changes come changes in the Children's Ministry schedule, too! Parents may drop off their children, grades PK-3, for programming during the Sunday school hour at 8:45 a.m., Fellowship Time at 9:30 a.m., or for Worship at 10:00 a.m. on the 2nd floor in the children's area. During the 10:00 a.m. worship time, the children will be brought down to participate in the Children's Sermon which will take place in the latter part of the service. They will re-join their parents afterward for the remainder of worship. Children who arrive at 8:45 a.m. or 9:30 a.m. will be able to stay in their classrooms for the duration of the morning. This will allow for the children to settle in for a longer class time with fewer transitions. Whether your children arrive at 8:45 a.m., 9:30 a.m. or 10:00 a.m., the classes will be going through planned transitions at these times and your child can jump right in. Heather Selement and I are looking forward to the upcoming months and welcome this new schedule with hopes that it will benefit our families with a longer class-time for the children and more time for fellowship and spiritual refreshment for parents.
